**TWO BURNER
STOVE WITH GRILL**

Hey! Please read this manual before using with your new Torpedo7 Stove.

Thank you for choosing this Torpedo7 product. We construct our products to meet the highest standards for performance and safety. When given the correct care and maintenance, this product will be useful for many years to come.

Before First Use

- Before first use, remove any stickers or similar from the stove
- Dispose of any plastic bags as they pose a risk of suffocation to young children.
- If the stove are transferred to a new owner, the manual should also be provided to the new owner.

Important Safety Measures and Precautions

- Improper installation, adjustment, alteration, service or maintenance can cause property damage, injury or death. Read these instructions for use carefully.

WARNING:

- Accessible parts may be very hot. Keep young children away at all times.
- Accessible parts may be very hot.

- Do not store or use petrol or other flammable vapor or liquids in the vicinity.
- Hazardous fire or explosion may result if this guide is ignored.

- Familiarise yourself with the appliance before connecting it to its gas container. Keep these instructions for future reference.

DANGER: IF YOU SMELL GAS:

1. Shut off gas supply to appliance.
2. Extinguish any open flame, avoid using any electrical appliance.
3. Check gas connections with soap solution before attempting to relight the stove.

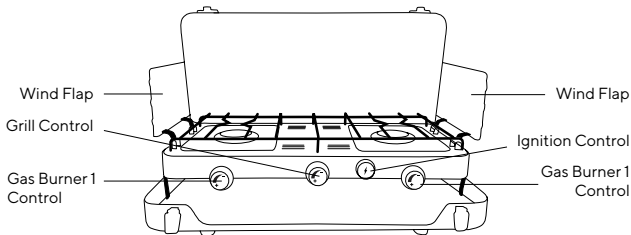
If odor still exists, immediately contact your gas supplier or fire department.

- Do not move the appliance during use
- Do not modify the appliance. Any Modification of the appliance may be dangerous
- Parts sealed by the manufacturer or his agent must not be altered by the user.
- Leak test all connections after each time you connect to the LPG cylinder and before each use.
- This Grill is NOT for commercial use.
- Never use an LPG tank with damaged body, valve, collar, or footing.
- Do not store a spare LPG tank under or near this appliance.
- The use of alcohol, prescription or non-prescription drugs may impair the ability to properly assemble or safely operate the appliance.
- Never use charcoal, lighter fluid, lava rocks, gasoline, kerosene, or alcohol within this stove.
- Do not store or use gasoline or other flammable liquids or vapors within 25 feet (7.6m) from this stove.
- Minimum clearance to combustible construction: 3 feet from side and 3 feet from back.
- Do not use this appliance under overhead combustible surface.
- Do not use the grill unless it's completely assembled and all parts are securely fastened.

- This grill should be thoroughly cleaned and inspected on a regular basis, clean and inspect the hose before each use of the appliance. If there is evidence of abrasion, wear, cuts or leaks, the hose must be replaced prior to the appliance being operated.
- Use only factory authorized parts. The use of any part that is not factory authorized is dangerous. This may also void your warranty.
- When cooking, fire extinguishing materials should be readily accessible.
- Use type B or C dry chemical fire extinguisher or smother with dirt, sand or baking soda.
- Operate on solid ground only, do not install or use in boats.
- Do not leave a lit grill unattended. Keep children and pets away from the stove at all times.
- Do not move the appliance during use.
- Move gas hoses as far away as possible from hot surfaces and hot grease splatter.
- Keep all electrical cords away from a hot stove.
- Turn o the gas supply at the gas container after use.
- Never obstruct the ventilation openings.
- When handling particularly hot components, protective gloves should be used.

Operation

WARNING:

- Before proceeding, make certain that you have assembled the appliance according to instructions.
 - Never use your stove in a building, garage, shed, breezeway, or any other enclosed area.
 - Never obstruct the flow of ventilation air around your stove housing.
 - Inspect the gas supply hose prior to turning the gas "ON". If there is evidence of cuts, wear or abrasion, it must be replaced prior to use. Check leakage before use. Do not use the grill if the odor of gas is present.
1. Open the lid by releasing catches. Open and attach the two windshields to the lid.
 2. Inspect the gas supply hose prior to turning the gas "ON". If there is evidence of cuts, wear or abrasion, it must be replaced prior to use. Check leakage before use. Do not use the grill if the odor of gas is present.
 3. Place stove on a flat, level, sturdy surface.
 4. For models with piezo ignition, rotate the electronic igniter whilst opening the control valve.
 5. Holding a lit match near the burner whilst opening the control valve can also light the stove.
 6. When burner is lit, turn the control knob clockwise to decrease the heat intensity or extinguish, and Anticlockwise to increase. Do not open valve beyond point where maximum intensity is reached as this may cause unnecessary flaring and waste gas.
 7. The stove must be used on a stable horizontal surface. Ensuring that the stove is secure.
 8. Be careful not to touch hot parts of this stove during and after use. Handle with care. Keep children away from this appliance.
 9. Extinguish by turning control knob fully clockwise. Check that the

stove is fully extinguished and the cylinder valve is closed before leaving the cooking area.

- Recommended Pan Size: 10-20cm

Installing Gas Supply

CONNECT LP GAS CYLINDER

- Before connecting, be sure that there is no debris caught in the valve of the LP tank, or in the burner ports.
- Connect the hose assembly to the stove by turning clockwise until it stops. Then connect the QCC regulator to the LPG cylinder.

LEAK TEST

- Cover both stove inlet connection and QCC regulator connection with a 50/50 solution of dish washing soap liquid and water.
- Open the LPG cylinder valve and check for bubbles to indicate a gas leak. If a leak is detected, tighten the connection and repeat the leak test. **DO NOT** use this stove unless all connections are gas tight and leak free.
- If you cannot stop a gas leak, close the cylinder valve and **DO NOT** use the stove.
- **DANGER:** When changing the gas container, care must be taken to keep away from any source of ignition.

DISCONNECT LP GAS CYLINDER

- Before disconnecting make sure the LP gas tank valve is in "CLOSED"
- Disconnect gas line from LP gas cylinder by turning counterclockwise until it is loose.

Cleaning and Maintenance

- Store in a cool, dry place when not in use.
- Storage temperatures should not exceed 30°C.
- Clean your stove and lenses using only lukewarm soapy water, rinse and then leave it to dry away from direct sunlight.
- Do not use chemical products such as solvents or detergents to clean the stove.
- Once fully cooled, disconnect the LPG cylinder, fold up the stove and store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place.
- If the stove is to be stored indoors, the gas cylinder must be disconnected and left outside. The gas cylinder should always be stored outside, in a dry, well-ventilated area, away from any sources of heat or ignition. Keep out of the reach of children
- Do not transport or store with gas connected.
- If you suspect a gas leak or malfunction, stop using immediately, extinguish and disconnect from the gas supply. Have the appliance tested by a qualified person. Do not modify the appliance.

Warranty

- Retain your receipt as proof of purchase.
- Inspect your stove before the beginning of a season or after a fall to ensure they are still intact. The lens must not be split, the strap must be securely fastened to the frame and the frame should not have any cracks in it. In the event that any such damage is found, the defective part must be replaced.

Torpedo7 products have a minimum 12 month warranty from date of purchase. Warranty claims cover any fault, defect or failure occurring as a result of the manufacturing process. Damage or faults occurring as a result of misuse, accident or wear and tear are not covered by our warranty policy.

If the product is still under warranty then the repair will be at our expense including the freight to return the repaired or replacement product. If the product is out of warranty, then we can still have the product repaired, however, the cost of the repair will be charged to the customer.
